


Large format (36" x 200") PDF printing for GenoPro

(I think the maximum dimension for a PDF is normally 200")


First download and install the latest Pdf995 printer driver (version 16) and the Free Converter (version 1.5) from www.pdf995.com/download.html (it seems that both are needed)



Then open your .gno file in GenoPro, and performed the following steps:


File/Printer Setup

Select the PDF995 printer option, then navigate via the Properties tab and Layout Advanced tab;



Change the paper size to "PostScript Custom Page Size"


Then edit "Custom Page Dimensions" and set to Inch, Width to 36" and Height to 200", (and set paper feed direction to "Long Edge First" if it's not already set to long edge first)




OK this.

Then set Graphic/ Print Quality to 600 DPI in the "PDF995 Printer Driver Advanced Options"; (I have also tried with this set to 300 DPI and it still works)
OK this, and more OK's to exit the "Print Setup" option and return to the main GenoPro window


Back in the main GenoPro window, go to File/Page Layout,
Set the left/right/top/bottom margins to 0.5 inches
Untick "Single Page" and "Landscape" and delete the numbers in "Paper Dimension" (select with mouse & then "Delete" key;



Then re-tick "Single Page" which will re-load the "Paper Dimension" box
 It will also select Landscape mode, and change the Printable area values to be Paper size less margins in each direction.
 OK this to return to main GenoPro window




Then File/Print Preview, which should show a complete preview of your .gno print.




Chose the "Print" tab at top left of Print Preview screen, to start printing your PDF

Check that printer name shown is PDF995,




Press OK to continue.
(you will be asked to confirm file-name & where to save)



Press Save to continue.

Do not worry about the various sponsor adverts which appear during the print stage, they do not appear on your final PDF print



Watch the progress bar to monitor the printing status, when the printing PDF to file is completed, you can close any "advert" windows
